## WHAT RESOURCES ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE ADVANCING EXCELLENCE CAMPAIGN?

The <u>Advancing Excellence website</u> serves as a catalyst for tracking and monitoring progress of your selected goals, and provides a wealth of resources for quality improvement in long-term care. These include those related to each Campaign goal. The table below outlines some of the available resources, using the pressure ulcer goal as an example; the bulleted list that follows clarifies each resource type.

**Note:** Resources are currently being updated with the listing of new goals. As resources become available, the icon will be placed in the appropriate area on the table.

- Explore Goal provides some baseline information that will help your team decide what you want to change.
- **Identify Baseline** contains a tracking tool relevant to the goal, and instructions on how to use the tracking tool. This is to help your team establish the baseline/starting point.
- **Examine Process** contains probing questions to help evaluate current processes and provide guidance for making improvements.
- **Improve** contains a PDSA (Plan, Do, Study, Act) cycle to help you create and assess changes made. Links to relevant resources and best practices are also housed here.
- **Leadership** contains fact sheets to help keep all of your stakeholders (residents, family members, staff, etc) involved and informed about the process.
- Monitor and Sustain will contain the data tracking tool for your team to collect and submit data, ensuring that plans are working and improvements have been sustained, as evident in the data.
- **Celebrate** will contain documents of visible celebration and recognition to allow your nursing home to create a "spirit of community" for a job well done!
